As a spiritual leader in our congregation, the Director will be visionary, creating and articulating a well-defined theological framework for music and worship through well-crafted contemporary idioms as well as more traditional methods and materials.

The successful candidate for the position will be an inspired and inspiring director of our chancel choir, facilitate the musical and spiritual growth of our family choir and 4th Sunday ensemble through close collaboration with their director, and work collegially with the rector, staff and diocesan peers. Excellent interpersonal skills are required for successful program and budget management, liturgical planning, and long term strategic thinking.
