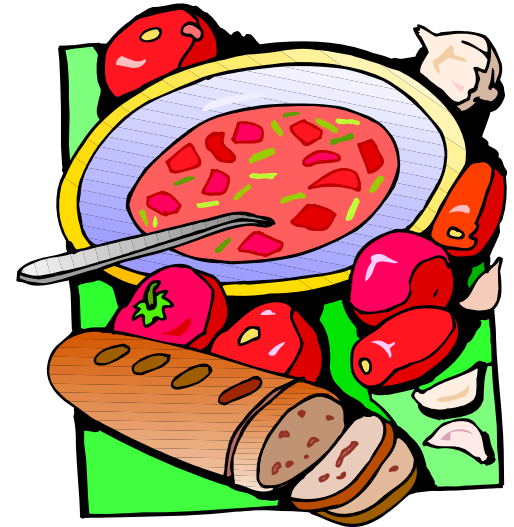

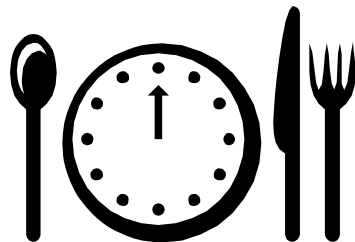
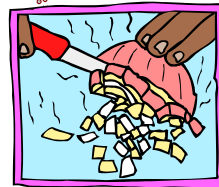

OUTREACH TO THE COMMUNITY

Since April 1983, All Saints has served a hot meal every Saturday to anyone who has walked through our doors. In 20 years, over 80,000 meals have gone to those who otherwise would have gone hungry.

Each week, eight to fifteen volunteers work to make this happen. Our dedicated volunteers come from All Saints, Reed College, other churches, and the community at large. Last year, volunteers put in 2,200 hours.

The Hot Meals Program fulfills a vital need in Southeast Portland, serving needy people of Woodstock, Lents, and Brentwood/Darlington. We are one of the few agencies which provides meals on Saturdays.
